Pro-Novice 2 runs \$40 each run / includes a full cross drive
Pro-Novice1 starts Friday at 8 AM Pro-Novice 2 will follow right after
Any unnecessary chasing of the sheep will not be tolerated.

Nursery 3 runs \$35 per run
Nursery 1 after Pro-Novice 2 same course.
Nursery 2 before Open 1 on Saturday Nursery 3 after Open 1 on Saturday

Open 2 Runs \$50 per dog
Open Starts after Nursery 1 on Saturday

Novice 2 runs \$ 35 per dog both runs Sunday afternoon after Open
Outrun, Lift, Fetch, wear drive thru panels then pen.

Start times may change depending on entries weather and Covid-19 restrictions.

Camping: to reduce contact the fair grounds has asked us to collect camping fees.
Full Hookup- \$45, Electric and Water-\$35, Non-Electric-\$27 per night. **Separate check for camping fees**

Covid-19 Plan

We will be camping along the north side of the fairground **Not by the maintenance shed.**

Porta pots and hand wash station will be provided near the handlers. Please use your own camper when possible . We will be following the USBCHA guidelines. No Post (A cone instead) Pen will have no gate no rope. Exhaust gate will be manned so less people touching the gate. No bleachers bring a chair and no tent.
Please follow the Covid-19 suggestions from the USBCHA website handout.

We will not be having **handler meetings** as suggested in the guidelines.

Pro-Novice and Nursery Outrun, Lift Fetch, Drive full course (left or right designated by the layout we all know what that means) pen. Time will be determined at the trial. Pen will be free standing with no gate no rope pen is called when all sheep have crossed plane of opening. No chasing of sheep and stay in bounds of the trial field.

Open Outrun, Lift, Fetch Drive full course, Pen and Shed 2 off of 5 or split if we run 4 sheep. Pen will be free standing with no gate no rope pen is called when all sheep have crossed plane of opening.

Novice Outrun, Lift, Fetch, wear thru panels then pen.

Course times will be determined and announced at the trial.

How do I stay safe while at a sheepdog trial?
From USBCHA hand out

The risk of getting corona virus during a sheepdog trial is low but not zero, and since many of our fellow handlers are of retirement age and at increased risk for severe illness, we need to do what we can to keep everyone safe. Here are some suggestions:

1. Maintain social distancing: stay 6 feet apart and avoid handshaking, hugging, or kissing. This won't be easy when we see each other so infrequently, but these measures have been very successful at slowing the epidemic.
2. Don't touch your face! The virus enters your body through your eyes, nose and mouth. If you have touched an infected surface and then touch your face, you could get ill.
3. Please wear a face covering in all public areas and inside porta potties. Face coverings capture your respiratory droplets and prevent most of the virus from getting into the air. They also remind you not to touch your face!
4. Sanitize your hands after touching shared surfaces, like gates. Trial hosts may provide hand sanitizer at these spots but you should bring your own just in case.
5. Porta potties probably represent the highest risk. Please use sanitizer BEFORE and AFTER you enter. Pump the doors open and closed several times before you go inside to help clear any aerosolized virus particles. If possible, block the door open after you are finished.
6. Bring your own chair –don't expect the trial host to have extras.
7. By all means, stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms or have reason to believe you may have been in contact with someone who has COVID-19.
8. Don't crowd around the judge's tent or the scoreboard. Take a picture of the scores so you can look at it elsewhere to avoid congregating in one spot
9. Bring your own food.

I understand and agree that failure by my family and/or myself to comply with the Trial Rules will result in my family and I being required to immediately leave the Trial and Jefferson County Fair Park. I understand that even following the Trial Rules may not prevent me and/or my family from contracting COVID-19 at the Trial and agree that the Releasers hereby release the Fair Park and Trial Participants of any and all responsibility or liability in the event I or any of my family contract COVID-19 at the Trial.
